However, with the lake levels being slightly over the high end of the MNRF's target range right now, not much of this shoal is visible.

On June 18th 70mm fell in the one day. Since June 25th the Parry Sound Coast Guard measured 80.6 mm of rain.

Please boat carefully and keep boat wakes low since docks, Loon nests and shorelines are particularly easily damaged now. Shoreline erosion puts extra phosphorus in the lake water which can promote algae over growth (blooms) which nobody wants.

With the sunny weather this week, hopefully water levels will recede to normal soon!
